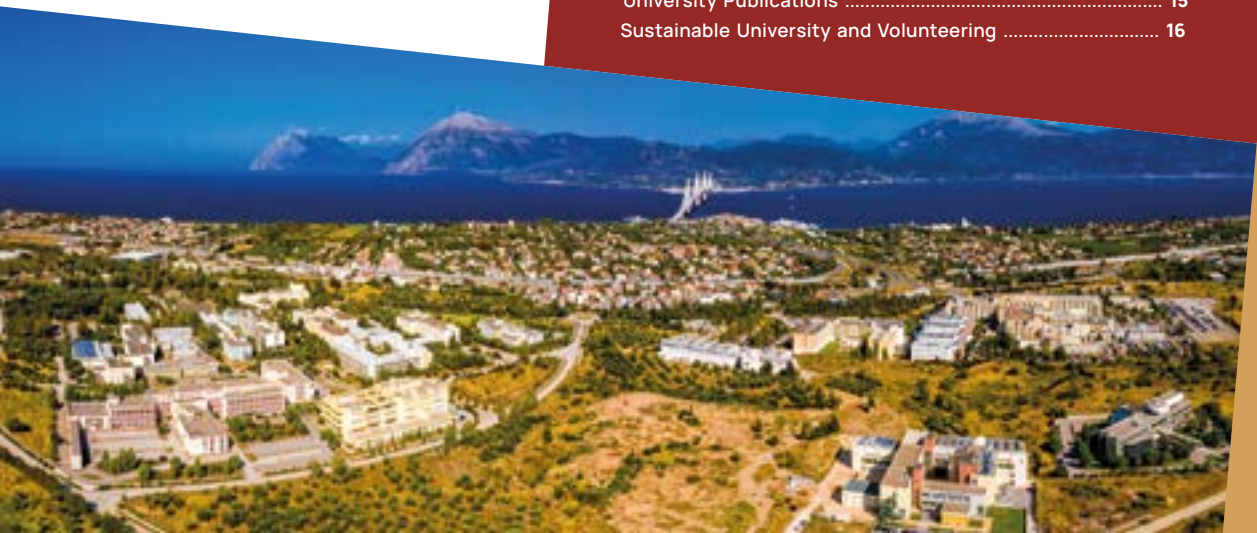

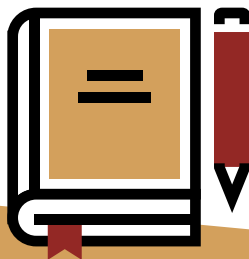


Quality Assurance

University of Patras (UPatras) is one of the most distinguished universities nationally and internationally owing to its manifold and innovative action in Natural Sciences, Engineering, Health Sciences, Humanities, Social and Economic Sciences, along with its remarkable research activity. The University was founded in 1964 with the vision of becoming widely-recognized for cultivating the spirit of international cooperation and scientific progress. In 2013, the University of Western Greece was integrated into UPatras. In 2019, the majority of the Departments of the Technological Educational Institute of Western Greece were also integrated into UPatras. To manage its premises and facilities in the cities of Patras, Messolonghi, Agrinio, the University has adopted the principles of sustainable development. Rio Campus is located in close distance from the historical center of Patras, Greece's third-largest city, where development of new technologies is vastly supported.

In 2018, UPatras was the first Institution in Greece to receive accreditation for its Internal Quality Assurance System (IQAS), in compliance with the Hellenic Authority for Higher Education (HAHE) Quality Standards as well as the Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area (ESG).

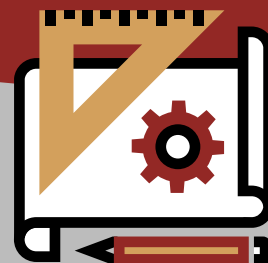

International Relations



From 2014 to 2020, in the context of Erasmus+ KA103, mobilities from UPatras included:

1,095 students for studies

779 students for traineeships

351 faculty members for teaching

139 staff for training

while UPatras hosted:

661 incoming students



Adopting internationalization principles, UPatras International Affairs Unit is responsible for coordinating and promoting the development of partnerships between the University and other Institutions abroad.

The main aim of the University is one of the tangible forms of internationalization: Erasmus+ as the flagship of the European Commission. UPatras manages Erasmus+ Mobility Projects (Key Action 1 – Learning Mobility of Individuals) within and outside the European Union by signing Inter-Institutional Agreements with Higher Education Institutions in and outside the EU (International Credit Mobility). Through these Projects, students and staff of the University are given the opportunity of mobility to partner-Institutions and/or other bodies abroad.

Students of all study cycles and from all disciplines are given the opportunity to study abroad in partner-Institutions or to do their traineeship in a company, research institute, laboratory, organization or any other relative to their studies work field, in order to:

- ▶ further develop their learning outcomes;
- ▶ develop their intercultural, language and digital skills; and
- ▶ personally develop and adjust in new contexts.

Teaching and administrative staff is provided with the opportunity to participate in Erasmus+ through activities that include teaching and training periods with the aim of:

- ▶ acquiring experience in new teaching environments;
- ▶ acquiring innovative educational and digital skills;
- ▶ cooperating with colleagues to plan joint activities;
- ▶ exchanging good practices; and
- ▶ enhancing the cooperation between higher education Institutions.

In the context of International Credit Mobility, beyond the European borders, Erasmus+ is based on Inter-Institutional agreements with partner-countries, such as: Morocco, Tunisia, Mozambique, Nigeria, China, Russia, Armenia, Algeria, Israel, Pakistan, Brazil, South Africa, Australia, Angola, and Canada.

We manage Erasmus+ through a top-down procedure, based on which its policy and terms are transferred from the European Commission to UPatras from the National Agency/IKY to the responsible Committee of our Institution and all Departmental Coordinators. Managing of the mobilities is aligned with the European Higher Education Area as for the ECTS and full recognition of mobility periods. The core aim of UPatras is to enhance mobility of students and staff through Erasmus+ for both outgoing and incoming flows.

Research

The Research Committee's Finance & Administration Unit (MODY-ELKE) acts as the main lever for putting in practice strategies aimed at the promotion and development of research excellence.

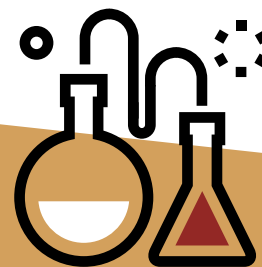

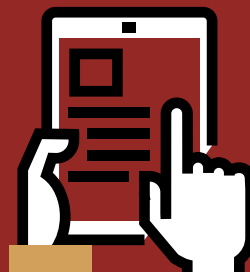


Alumni Network

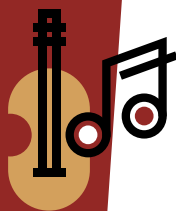

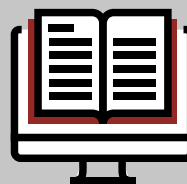
